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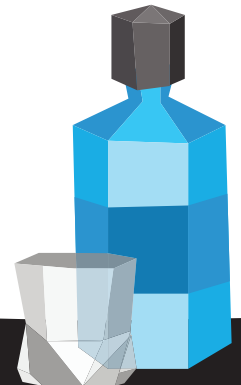

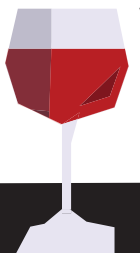

Prosecco is Italy's most popular sparkling wine. Light, refreshingly and effervescent it is an integral part of most luncheons, weddings, birthday parties and other celebrations throughout Italy. The name Prosecco is derived from the Italian village of Prosecco near Trieste, where the grape and wines are said to have originated.

Bellavista was established in 1977 by Mr. Vittorio Moretti to make sparkling wine. It is the embodiment of the dreams and drive of the Moretti family, shaped by the philosophy and hard work of its forward-thinking founders and inspired by the beauty of the Franciacorta landscape.

The Franciacorta region that is home to Bellavista, is a D.O.C area located in the province of Brescia in the eastern part of Italy's Lombardia region. The Bellavista winery has truly unique climatic and geological features.

SPARKLING

Franciacorta Vendemmia Rose | DOCG Brut | 2017 | 12% Chardonnay 62%, Pinot Nero 38% 165

A pale and lovely mousse, while its perlage consists of small, densely packaged and persistent bubbles. Pale pink colour that over time takes on aristocratic antique rose hues. Sensations of white peach, intense yet mellow character, pleasing fragrances of wild strawberries, citrus fruit, golden delicious apples and dog rose, with a lingering hint of toasted bread. Undertones of blackcurrant and sweet almond, and there is a clear sensation of small wood berries.

Franciacorta Teatro alla Scala | DOCG Brut | 2019 | 12.5% Chardonnay 72%, Pinot Nero 28% 144

Compact and very silky mousse. A continuous and uninterrupted crown of bubbles that remains unaltered for an extended time. Bright colour tone, deep and crystalline clarity. A persistent aroma of white blooms, with delicate honeysuckle and rose notes. Warm hints of candied fruit and intense Mediterranean citrus notes. Sweet but not overly so and vibrantly persistent.

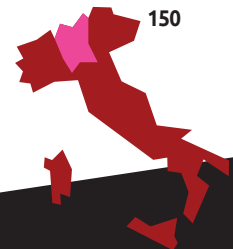
Franciacorta Alma Grande Cuvée | DOCG N/V | Brut | 12.5% Pinot Nero 22%, Chardonnay 77%, Pinot Bianco 1% 90

Bright Yellow in colour and luminous with obvious glints of green. The bouquet is characterised by strong minerality, embraces hints of sweet ripe fruit, meringue, pastries and candied citrus peel. Flavour that fully matches the nose, with creamy, almost crunch sensation and a texture of lightness, depth and harmony.

WHITE

Uccellanda Curtefranca Bianco | DOC | 2018 | 13.5% 150

Its colour is yellow with golden reflections. The bouquet is broad, refined, with a soothing touch of vanilla, perfectly balanced with hints of golden delicious apples, quince and ripe fruit. The taste is full of elegance, smoothness and structure. Very persistent.



PIEMONTE

Piemonte enjoys an unrivalled seat among the world's very finest wine regions. Located in north west Italy it is the home of more DOCG wines than any other Italian region, among them such well known and respected names as Barolo and Barbaresco. Although famous for its austere, tannic and floral red wines made from the Nebbiolo grape, Piemonte's greatest success story in the past decade has been sweet, white, sparkling Moscato d'Asti.

RED

**GAJA Sito Moresco | Langhe DOP | 2020 | 14%
Nebbiolo, Barbera, Merlot** 145

Sito Moresco combines the complexity of Nebbiolo with the roundness of Barbera and the body of Merlot. Ruby red in colour. Refined bouquet of small red fruits, oak and leather. In the mouth it is elegant, fruity and harmonious. Very elegant.

Cascina Chicco | Rocche di Castelletto Barolo DOCG | 2019 | Nebbiolo | 14.5% 135

On the nose, this wine is elegant, with complex notes of raspberry, liquorice, and spices. It is full-bodied, powerful, and balanced by the sweetness of the tannins that characterise its lasting impression on the palate.

Marchesi di Barolo | Barolo La Tradizione | DOCG | 2019 | 13.6% 135

Garnet red with ruby hues. Intense aromas of spices; cinnamon, tobacco and rose bush. The is full and elegant with soft tannins. Full bodied.

Marchesi di Barolo | Barbaresco La Tradizione | DOCG | 2019 | Nebbiolo | 13.5% 129

Garnet red with ruby reflection. Aroma is intense and persistent with distinct traces of fruit, wild rose and spices. The taste is full and vigorous a balanced.

Cascina Chicco | Langhe Nebbiolo | DOC | 2022 | 14.5% 80

The colour is red and it has an ethereal elegant fragrance; there are hints of violet, marasca cherry, and final notes of spice. It's full, aristocratic, and delicate.

Bricco Maiolica | Barbera d'Alba | DOC | 2021 | 13% 75

Ruby red in colour, a very fruity wine with hints of black currant, black cherry and plums. Fine and delicate low tannins. Medium bodied.

SWEET

Elio Perrone | Moscato d'Asti | DOCG | 2023 | 12.7% 69

Yellow, changing towards green, vivid, brilliant. Intense, polyhedral: it recalls orange flowers, yellow peach, sage and just picked Muscat grapes. Sweet and harmonic, well balanced, with a typical Muscat's acidity.

VENETO

The Veneto wine region is Italy's production workhorse. Although it doesn't have the same fame as Toscana or Piemonte, it makes 18% of Italy's wine and is replete with amazing wine. Unlike other Italian wine regions, Veneto makes world-class wines across the spectrum; Sparkling Prosecco to rich Amarone, the diversity in microclimates gives this wine region a unique edge.

WHITE

**Bertani | Sereole | Soave | DOC | 2022 | 13%
Garganega 100%** 65

A straw-yellow colour with golden highlights, floral bouquet of elderflower and pear developing into the aromas of yellow fleshed fruits such as apricot, pineapple and melon. Plush on the palate, balanced with sapid notes that enhance the structure.

Villa Chiopris | Pinot Grigio | Friuli Grave | DOC | 2022 | 12.5% 60

Straw yellow colour. Its bouquet is flowery and recalls the flowers of the lime; on the palate it is fresh, medium-bodied with a long finish.

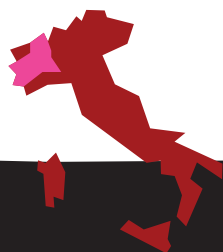

Dark ruby red colour. Intense and complex with notes of blackberry, cherries and dried red roses, sweet spicy scents of vanilla, coffee and leather. Elegant tannicity.

Rondinella 10%, Corvina Veronese 75%, Molinara 5%** 65

Bright ruby-red wine and has a lively bouquet with hints of red fruits and fresh, floral notes that give an extraordinary aromatic finesse. Well-structured and balanced by a pleasant touch of acidity that lingers.



ABRUZZO

Abruzzo is an Italian wine region located in the mountainous central Italian region. It has a long history of wine production. 65% of Abruzzo's rugged terrain is mountainous which helped to isolate the region from the winemaking influence of the ancient Romans and Etruscans in Tuscany. Known primarily for the production of the Montepulciano grape, Montepulciano D'Abruzzo is one of the most widely exported DOC wine from Italy.

ROSE

Collefriso | Rosé | Terre di Chieti IGT | 2023 | Montepulciano D'Abruzzo | Ortona | 13% 60
Cherry red colour with pink reflections. Nice fruity scent, containing hints of cherry and cherry plum. A fresh, fragrant and lasting taste, well balanced and with a good structure.

RED

Collefriso | Vignaquadra | Montepulciano d'Abruzzo | DOC | 2019 | Ortona | 13.5% 70
Ruby red colour. Intensive fruity scent, containing hints of spice, cherry plum and jam. Well balanced with a long lasting taste.

TOSCANA

Toscana is the most enduringly famous of all Italian wine regions thanks to the romantic glamour of its endless rolling hills, and hilltop villages. Situated in central Italy, Toscana has a long wine history that can be traced back as far as the fifth century BC. The region stands tall, its reputation founded on iconic wines including Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano.

Giorgio Meletti Cavallari | Borgeri Bolgheri Bianco | DOC | 2022 13.5% 65
Vermentino 50%, Viognier 50%
Yellow Straw colour with green reflections. Complex and intense in the nose with hints of fresh white-pulp fruits like banana and pear. Citrus zest and yellow fruits with floral sensations. Harmonious and fresh with mineral tones and superb persistence.

RED

Tenute Silvio Nardi | Brunello di Montalcino | DOCG | 2018 | Sangiovese | 14% 155
Intense ruby red colour. Clean sophisticated, intense and complex aroma, rich in evolved overtones, with hints of anise, ripe wild berries and a light touch of vanilla.

Giorgio Meletti Cavallari | Impronte Bolgheri Superiore | DOC | 2019 | 14% 149
Carbnet Sauvignon 70%, Cabernet Franc 30%
Ruby red colour, intense bouquet with a fragrance of small red fruits and scents Of mint and liquorice. The taste is structured full bodied with soft and aromatic tannins and a well balanced acidity.

Villa Trasqua | Fanatico Chianti Classico Riserva | DOCG | 2017 | 14% 119
Sangiovese 80%
Aromas of violets and red forest fruits, ripe cherries, plums and blueberries. Balanced spices and elegant vanilla notes. Persistent on the palate and prominent tannins. Full bodied.

Castello di Querceto | Chianti Classico | DOCG | 2022 | 13% 70
Sangiovese 92%, Red grapes 8%
Brilliant ruby red, compound, with soft and elegant texture. Fruity aromas, balanced with herbal notes. Interesting final.

Castello di Querceto | Sangiovese | Toscana IGT | 2022 | 12.5% 60
Ruby red with violet hues. Aromas of red berry lead the nose. Light-bodied, simple palate suggests juicy red cherry and the barest hint of ground clove



SICILIA

Sicilia is Italy's southernmost region, and the largest island in the Mediterranean Sea. For more than 2500 years Sicilia has been a significant centre of Mediterranean viticulture. Once famous for sweet Muscats, and later fortified Marsala, the island's best known wines are now its dry table wines produced under the regional IGT title, Terre Siciliane. The warm, dry climate with coastal breezes creates a low disease pressure meaning that chemical sprays are hardly needed and much of Sicilia's wine is produced from organic grapes.

WHITE

IDDA | Bianco Sicilia | GAJA | DOP | 2021 | 12.5% 160
Carricante 100%

Collaboration between Alberto Graci and Angelo Gaja. Notes of tomato leaves, sage, melon and quince, followed by hints of honey and hay. Notes of yeast and dough rising from the glass. The palate is voluptuous, enriched by yellow plum and pineapple for a sleek acidity. Clean-cut, savoury mineral-laced finish.

Donnafugata Dolce & Gabbana | Isolano Etna Bianco | Sicilia DOC | 2021 | 12.5% 120
Straw yellowing colour, hints of yellow fruits and citrus fruits stand out on the nose followed by notes of mediterranean herbs.

Fondo Antico | Grillo Parlante | IGT Sicilia | 2022 | 13.5% 60
Grillo 100%

Glistening yellow colour with green hints. Its bouquet marries the delicacy of the flowers to the sweetness of the white fruit giving voice to the chirping cricket of its namesake. Freshness and good sapidity.

RED

Donnafugata Dolce & Gabbana | Cuor di Lava Etna Rosso | DOC | 2020 | 12.5% 195
Ruby red in colour. On the nose bouquet of wild berries, orange peel and cinnamon, refreshed by aroma of slight balsamic and floral hints, and lavender.

IDDA | Etna Rosso | GAJA | DOP | 2020 | 43.5% 160
Nero D'Avola 100%

Collaboration between Alberto Graci and Angelo Gaja. Violet, black cherry and mulberry, ripe and sweet fruit on the palate, with accents of tomato leaves and oregano. Juicy, fresh, with ripe and well-integrated tannins, lingering finish.

Fondo Antico | Nero D'avola | Sicilia DOC | 2021 | 13.5% 60
Nero D'Avola 100%

A different version of the most common grape in Sicilia. It is a fresh, fruity and long-lived wine. Bouquet of cherry and soft fruit.

SWEET

Fondo Antico | Baccardoro Passito | IGT Terre Siciliane | 12% | 500ml 90
Zibibbo 50% Grillo 50%

Golden yellow hue, clear. A delicious, sweet combination of almonds, cookies, dried figs and candied oranges. Intense, but with great freshness.

SARDEGNA

Off the west coast of Italy, Sardegna is the second-largest island in the Mediterranean Sea. The island's separation from the mainland has led to a unique culture and identity, somewhat removed from the Italian mainstream. This is reflected in the Sardinian relationship with wine and the varieties planted here.

For much of its modern winemaking history Sardegna was governed by Spain, and many of its distinctive local grape varieties such as Bovale Sardo (Graciano), Bovale Grande (Mazuelo) and Cannonau (Garnache) are Spanish in origin.

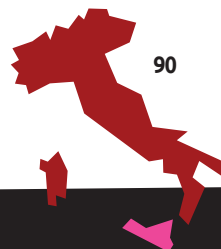
The Sardegna wine region covers around 40,000 hectares of terrain. Vines are grown mainly in the rolling hills of Campidano between the capital Cagliari and Oristano in the southwest and in the plateaus north of Olbia around Sassari and Alghero.

Ruby red colour, aromas of red fruit, wild strawberries, thyme and herbs. The palate is rich and warm with soft tannins and a persistent finish.



PUGLIA

Some of the best values in Italian wine come from this sunny, dry region. Puglian wine is the product of a diverse landscape; surrounded by water on three sides, the cool breezes from the Mediterranean moderate vineyard temperatures, and the warm climate and fertile soil make it easy to grow almost anything. The majority of Puglian wine is red, full-bodied and will pair well with a wide variety of foods. Producers in Puglia have focused on making great red wines, with local grapes like Negroamaro and Primitivo which make for delicious drinking.

Intense and brilliant golden, straw-yellow colour. Its aroma is intense and fruity. The palate is striking for its fresh liveliness and its balance. It is structured, harmonious, persistent and delicate.
